**Call for Participants**

KU faculty have the opportunity to apply for the Spring 2008 Proposal Writing Workshop, which will be led by two faculty directors who have had considerable experience with external grant applications. The aim of the workshop is to ensure that each participant has a competitive application ready by the end of April for submission to the NEH fellowship competition, and/or to other national grant competitions. The workshop will meet between January and April with the exact dates to be negotiated with the co-directors, who will meet with the workshop on each occasion. A planning meeting will be held in December. Since the aim of the workshop is to build a core group of participants who will help each other to develop their proposals, acceptance of membership implies agreement to attend all sessions.

**Application Deadline:** All application materials are due on or before **November 19, 2007 at 5:00 p.m.**

**Provide to the Hall Center TWO (2) copies of the complete application, collated in the order shown. Materials received after 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date will not be considered.**

- Application Cover Sheet** (Note: please include an indication of your availability for a planning meeting in the period December 10-14 inclusive.)
- Two page vitae** that includes:
  1. record of applicant's education, including the dates when degrees were awarded
  2. record of applicant's employment
  3. list of applicant's publications; include page numbers for journal articles and book chapters
  4. list of applicant's awards and grants received during the last five years
- Proposal Project Description not to exceed two double-spaced pages.**
- A list of potential agencies to which the proposal could be submitted.**
