KU faculty have the opportunity to apply for the Spring 2007 Proposal Writing Workshop, which will be led by two faculty directors who have had considerable experience with external grant applications. The aim of the workshop is to ensure that each participant has a competitive application ready by the end of April for submission to the NEH fellowship competition, and/or to other national grant competitions. The workshop will meet bi-weekly between January and April. The exact dates will be negotiated with the co-directors, who will meet with the workshop on each occasion. A planning meeting will be held in December. Since the aim of the workshop is to build a core group of participants who will help each other to develop their proposals, acceptance of membership implies agreement to attend all sessions.

Applications are due at the Hall Center by 5:00 pm on Monday, November 13, 2006, for a December 1 decision. Please send or deliver to Jay Coffman at the Hall Center. Applications must include:

- a proposal title
- a one-page summary of the proposal
- a two-page CV or resume
- a list of potential agencies to which the proposal could be submitted

Please include in your cover letter your campus and email address, and an indication of your availability for a planning meeting in the period December 11-15 inclusive.
